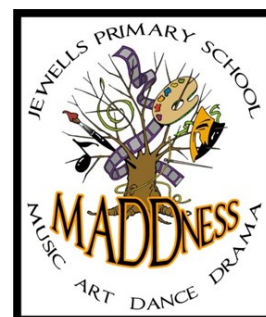

But now I wish I never went to that festival. The festival that turned to horror. The day I lost my parents.

We had been waiting for what felt like hours when the first festive float strolled into view. This float had one million little lights attached to it, in lots of different colours, but what followed was a peculiar site. A large group of men, women and children just like me locked inside a cage on wheels pleading for help. That was the moment it hit me. This wasn't a festival, it was a trap!

This event was planned by sneakers, the people who attract others to enslave them. Anyone who refused got shot. I turned to my mother for help but she wasn't there. Nor was father. This made me come to my senses, to realise that everyone was running around and screaming, pleading the sneakers not to take their children, worriedly grabbing their relatives' arms and leaving as fast as they could.

But me, I was just standing there, calling: "Mum! Daddy?" When I heard a reply. My name.

"Alice Alice." The name that everyone shamed my parents for because it was a name from overseas. But it was the last word I heard my parents speak. And it means more than the world to me.

To this day, if they are still alive, my parents are still enslaved. I've been waiting for them for 10 years now, and I've accepted that they will never come. One thing is for certain though; I will never give up to the sneakers. Ever.

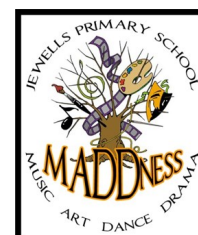
