### NATIONAL RIDE2SCHOOL DAY

Walk, bike ride, skate or scooter to school on March 13<sup>th</sup>, to celebrate active travel.



Children under 16 years of age (and adults supervising them) are allowed to ride on a footpath in NSW.

Encourage your kids to follow these tips for safer riding:

- Always wear an approved bicycle helmet, properly fitted and fastened.
- Always obey road rules, including traffic lights, stop signs and give way signs.
- Turn your head when passing driveways
- Keep left when riding on the footpath and give way to pedestrians
- Travel at a speed that is safe for you and others
- Wear bright clothing to make yourself visible

# Safety

around schools

## Road rules in school zones

### Pedestrian crossings

You cannot stop within 20 metres before a pedestrian crossing or 10 metres after a pedestrian crossing unless there is a control sign permitting parking.

*Minimum penalty: \$439 and two demerit points*

### Double parking

You may not stop on the road alongside to another vehicle at any time even to drop off or pick up passengers.

*Minimum penalty: \$330 and two demerit points*

### Parking on a verge

You cannot stop or park on a verge area (footpath, nature strip, dividing strip or kerb).

*Minimum penalty: \$183 and two demerit points*

### Slow down

Stick to the 40km/h speed limit in a school zone and look out for children who may be about.

### Kiss and ride

Some schools have 'kiss and ride' or 'drop-off and pick-up zones' for children in 'No Parking' zones. If your school has a program in place, remember to always drop off or pick up your child from the designated zone and follow the school's procedures. You can stop in a kiss and ride area for two minutes only to pick up passengers and you must stay within three metres of the vehicle.

If your school does not have a 'kiss and ride' program in place please use the 'No Parking' zone to drop off and pick up passengers.

- Cricket NSW will offer any school that enters a Boys and Girls team a FREE 2-hour School Blitz Skill Development Session as a sample for the in-School Programs that CNSW Delivers to prepare them for the Sixers Smash East Lakes Cup.
- Runs for 6 weeks finishing on Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> April as a Finals/ Play offs day. There will be 5 round games over 5 Friday sports afternoons from 28th February to 27th March and the Last week on Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> April will be the Final for the top 2 ranked teams in Boys and Girls Competition plus all other teams will play placement playoffs.
- Competition will run from 12-1.30pm
- Venue's – Local Premier Cricket Ovals will be used to host multiple Matches: I.e. Kahibah Oval- Kahibah, Cahill Oval- Belmont, Croudace bay Oval- Croudace Bay and Feighan Oval- Warners bay. Multiple Games on the One venue, Couch grass pitch unless ovals have Synthetic pitches.

- Cricket NSW will supply Ground Managers to set up the Games All Officials will have the up to date Safe Guarding Children Documents Including WWCC.
- Cricket NSW will supply the wickets and the balls and SOME Equipment for the matches (A Kookaburra Super Softer ball will be used) It is Optional for Schools to where protective equipment if they have adequate amount.
