Early Pick-ups

If it is absolutely necessary for your child to be picked up early from school, you will need to ring to notify the school office at least 30mins before the pickup time or send notification to the teacher.

Late arrivals

When your child arrives late to school, ring the office with the explanation and send them straight to the office for a late slip.

Payments of Camps, Incursions, Excursions or Events

Student Wellbeing


This year the school will be implementing My Wellbeing Journal activities, that create opportunities and personal spaces for students to express their feelings, fears, goals, struggles and opinions without fear of judgement from others. They are tools children can use to help get their private thoughts out of their minds and onto paper, while simultaneously learning techniques and strategies to cope with life's challenges.



Students will be offered exercises that focus on:
